Capital of Kenya.

The capital of Kenya is Nairobi.

Nairobi became the capital of Kenya in 1963.

Nairobi which translates to “cool water”, a reference to the Nairobi river which flows through the city, the town quickly grew to replace Mombassa as the capital of Kenya in 1907.

The city lies on the river Athi in the southern part of the country, and has an elevation of 1,795 metres (5,889 ft) above sea level.

Mount Kenya.

Mount Kenya is the highest mountain in Kenya and the second-highest in Africa, after Kilimanjaro.

The highest peaks of the mountain are Batian, Nelion and Point Lenana.

Mount Kenya is the source of the name of the republic of Kenya.

Mount Kenya is a stratovolcano created approximately 3 million years after the opening of the East African rift.

Where is Kenya?

Destination Kenya, a country in East Africa bordering the Indian Ocean in south east, neighboring countries are Ethiopia, Somalia, South Sudan, Tanzania, and Uganda.

With an area of 580,000 km² the country is somewhat larger than Metropolitan France or slightly twice the size of the U.S state Nevada.

What's the weather like in Kenya ?



Mostly Kenya's climate is warm all year round and the weather includes plenty of sunshine with cools nights and mornings.

Most parts of the country, the coolest season falls between July and August with temperatures dropping to the low 50's(°F). In as much as Kenya does not have summer in particular, the months between February and March are known to be the hottest season with temperatures going as high as 93°F.

Rainy season

Kenya is an agricultural country so the amount of rainfall affects the country's economy. It receives long showers from April to June while in October and December the rainfall is fairly low. The rest of the months experience little or no rain and January, February, August, and September are the dry months of Kenya.

Kenya has a rainy season almost every year. The northern region of Kenya receives very little rain while the central, coastal, and western parts receive more than 40-inch of rainfall each year.



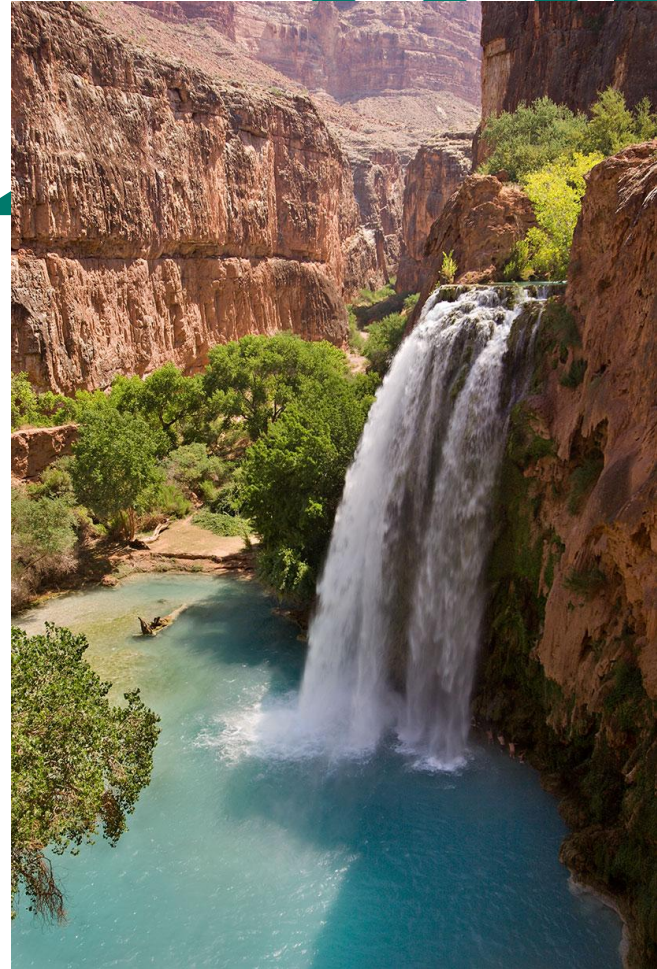
The Kenya's flag

Education in Kenya

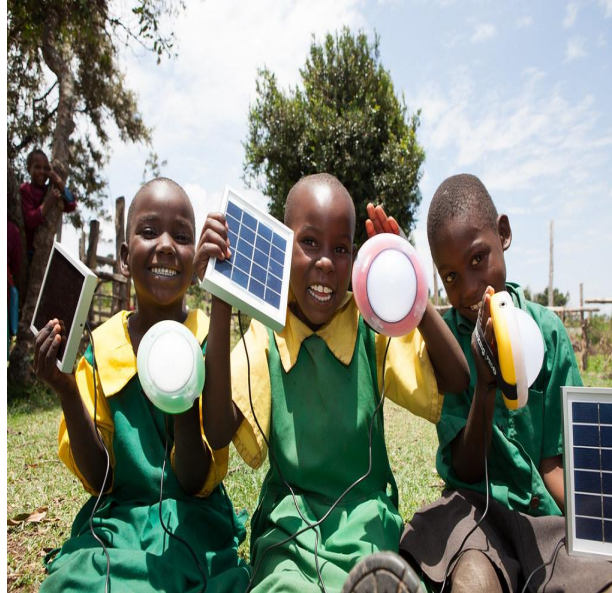
- Missionaries helped set up schools in Kenya
